


Barnby in the Willows Playground Equipment Project

Barnby in the Willows is a village and civil parish in the Newark and Sherwood district of Nottinghamshire, England, 4 miles East of Newark-on-Trent. According to the 2001 census it had a population of 244. Just to the south of the village is the River Witham, which also forms the border with Lincolnshire. 5 streets make up the centre of Barnby, these are:

- Front Street,
- Dark Lane,
- Cross Lane,
- Long Lane,
- Back Lane.

The village comprises circa 110 houses, the Parish Church of All Saints (13th Century), a village pub, a village hall, a village green and a small playing field owned by Barnby Manor Estates.
