

# **BARNBY IN THE WILLOWS PARISH COUNCIL**

## **Minutes of Additional Planning Meeting held on 29 March 2018 in the Village Hall at 6:30pm.**

### **PC/21/18 Attendance and Apologies**

### **PC/22/18 Declarations of Interest.**

There were no declarations of interest in items on the agenda.

### **PC/23/18 Public Contributions.**

There were no members of the public present.

### **PC/24/18 Planning Application 18/00177/FUL – Church Cottage, Front Street**

Plans for a two-storey extension to replace the single storey lean-to and a replacement conservatory on the south side of the cottage were discussed.

The Parish Council was pleased to see that the cottage was to be renovated. There were no objections to the two-storey side extension, but concerns were expressed about the style of the large white UPVC conservatory which was felt to be out of character with the old cottage, adjacent to a Grade 1 listed C13 church and within the Conservation Area. There were also objections to the proposed style of the windows of the new extension which were too modern for the style of the cottage.

Members were in favour of the over-all plans for renovation, but voted unanimously to reject the current proposal due to the style of the conservatory and new windows.

### **PC/25/18 Matters for immediate note and next agenda.**

Still a lot of litter in the lanes, there does not appear to have been a Council litter collection yet. The Council's road sweeper has damaged the road in Back Lane.
