

THE PARISH COUNCIL HAS A VACANCY FOR THE POSITION OF CLERK

Council meetings are held every other month. A salary of not less than £9.97 per hour will be paid with the number of hours per month to be agreed.

The Clerk is responsible for calling and attending meetings, preparing the agenda and minutes, maintaining financial records, providing information to the Parish Council and implementing decisions made by the Council. Training will be provided.

In addition to the post of Clerk, the Parish Council will also require an <u>administrator for the village website</u> and an <u>editor for the quarterly newsletter</u>. These could be combined with the work of the Clerk or could each be done separately on a voluntary basis if someone has a particular interest.
