### **Minutes of the Committee Meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2019 in the Village Hall at 7:00pm.**

#### **BVC/13/19 Apologies for Absence**

Apologies were received from Barbara Hill, Vicky Appleby, Graham Bett, Janette Barlow.

#### **BVC/14/19 Approval of Minutes**

Minutes of the Barnby Village Committee meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> September were agreed and signed by the Chairman.

#### **BVC/15/19 Matters Arising.**

It was agreed that a quorum for committee meetings would be 8 members present.

#### **BVC/16/19 Finance.**

Ticket sales for Sunjay on 11<sup>th</sup> October were £630 of which £515 inc VAT was to be paid to Live and Local (£400 fee + 50% of profit on ticket sales). Bar takings were £243.51 less net expenses of £118.13 = £125.38  
**Total income for the night = £326.21** (£217.26 banked, £108.95 vat refund) to be split between the Village Hall and village projects. Updated finance statement to be circulated for the next meeting.

#### **BVC/17/19 Events.**

##### b) Fireworks Night Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> November .

Final arrangements were agreed. Zurich Insurance had been informed of the change of venue and a new risk assessment had been completed. Tickets £5 adult, £2.50 child to include a hot dog. Soup and jacket potatoes also on sale, plus bar, mulled wine and raffle. Event to run from 5pm – 7pm.

##### c) Wreath Making Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> December.

Janette Barlow would take bookings – maximum 20 people. Ticket price to include wreath base and greenery, prosecco and light lunch.

##### d) Mini Christmas Fair Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> November.

Christmas themed afternoon tea, games/activities, raffle with Christmas hamper, table-top sales (£5 per table), £1 craft bag for children, wear a Christmas jumper. To be organised by V.A.,G.P., L.W., M.L. in the Village Hall from 2pm – 4pm.

##### e) Carol Singing Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> December.

Meet at Stump Corner at 4pm, collection in aid of Beaumont House. DP to organise sleigh.

##### f) Inter-lanes Quiz and Supper Quiz.

To be held in February and March – details to be discussed at the next meeting. Steve Beeching making flashing buzzer.

## **BVC/18/19 New proposals**

### Social club.

Mr and Mrs Steve Beeching had offered to donate a pool table to the Village Hall which would need to be kept permanently in the hall due to its weight. It could be used for a weekly/twice weekly games night with bar to create a hub for people to socialise, run by members of the committee. Afternoon activities such as whist drives, flower arranging, bingo could also be held during the week. The majority of the committee were in favour of asking for the Parish Council's consent to install the pool table and run a trial period of one evening and one afternoon a week from December.
